A West Berkshire Card allows residents of the District to benefit from discounted charges (approximately 10%) at a range of West Berkshire Council facilities. These include:-

- **“Pay as you go” admission charges and monthly membership fees at all of the Council’s Sports and Leisure Centres.**
- **10% discount on selected events at Shaw House, an Elizabethan Manor House on the outskirts of Newbury. Contact Shaw House for details.**
- **Hire Charges for Computer Games, Compact Discs and Digital Video Discs at the Council’s libraries.**

Although the new card can be used at all of these venues, it does need to be activated separately at leisure centres and libraries. If you already have a library card it will continue to allow you to borrow items from libraries across the District. You will only need to replace your library card if you want to take full advantage of the benefits listed above. Discounts at libraries will be activated at any library when you are issued with a new card. If you wish to activate the leisure centre discounts you will need to complete an application form and take it to one of the participating leisure centres where your photograph will be taken and your card issued.

All West Berkshire Cards are issued free of charge to West Berkshire residents. Young Person and concessionary Cards are valid for 12 months. All other cards are valid for 3 years.

To apply for your card at:

A Leisure Centre – please complete the enclosed form and take it with the required documentation to any West Berkshire Council leisure centre.

A Library – please visit any West Berkshire Library and complete the library membership form.

Please note NO West Berkshire Cards can currently be issued at Shaw House.

A Young Person West Berkshire Card is available to young people who are 16 years of age or under (Up to and including students in Year 11 at school). Junior admission charges apply.

A Concessionary West Berkshire Card is available to residents who are over 60 years of age and not in employment; residents with a disability; and residents in receipt of specified benefits.

As well as the completed application form, you will need to supply:-

For all adult applicants

- **Proof of identity** (e.g. Works photo ID card, Driving Licence) or Passport)
- **Proof of residency within West Berkshire.** (Council Tax bill, utility bill, bank statement or credit card bill addressed to you at your home address)

If you are applying for a Young Person or Concessionary Card you will also need to provide

- **Proof of age for Over 60’s concessions or junior cards**
- **Proof of entitlement to the following benefits:**
 - **Income Support**
 - **Job Seekers Allowance**
 - **Incapacity Benefit**
 - **Housing Benefit**
 - **Council Tax Benefit.**

If applying for a concession card for another family member you will need to provide proof that the benefit covers all dependants.
