Foreword

I am pleased to present West Berkshire District Council's Annual Parking Reports for the period from April 2010 to March 2012, the second and third years of Civil Parking Enforcement.

Our priorities remain unchanged in the use of parking enforcement to provide better traffic management and improved road safety, thereby achieving the objectives defined by the Council in the "Clear Streets" project.

In 2010/11 the Parking Service consolidated on the experience gained in the first year of operations. In 2011/12 bus lane enforcement at the Park Way Bridge in Newbury commenced in November 2011 to coincide with the opening of the Parkway development. There was an initial surge of contraventions, but I am very pleased that the numbers are now substantially reduced. The West Berkshire experience is very similar to that experienced by other councils who have implemented bus lane enforcement.

We are always alert to the needs of our diverse customer groups and the Parking Service always tries to meet those needs. In particular I am very aware that many residents who live near schools face problems caused by indiscriminate parking during the term-time morning and afternoon peaks when careless parking causes problems for other road users, pedestrians, residents and imperils the safety of the children. With over eighty schools in the district it will require multi-discipline action to resolve the problem and it cannot be resolved by the Parking Service alone.

We have adapted the style of this report to show only key statistical data as this provides a better illustration of the work undertaken by the Parking Service.
