All drivers should remember the needs of people with limited mobility (if you don't have a Blue Badge don't even think about parking in a Blue Badge space!) and people on the pavements and walkways including those with pushchairs, wheelchairs or visual impairment.

I hope you'll enjoy reading this report, but please don't assume that what we must record as 'net income' is real 'profit'. The truth is that we are obliged by law to reinvest any surplus directly in traffic management measures in West Berkshire – for example in operating the Blue Badge Scheme, providing pedestrian crossings, planning residents' parking schemes and, yes, in keeping our car parks in good condition.

We were delighted this year to once again be awarded the British Parking Association's prestigious ParkMark for many of our car parks. This is a good sign that we're doing a difficult job well and I hope you think so too.

Parking Penalty Charge Notices

In the period April 2018 to March 2019 the Council issued **6,804** parking penalty charge notices. Of this total of penalty charge notices:

- (a) 3,190 were issued in the car parks (off-street); of which
 - 173 were issued for higher level contraventions and
 - 3,017 were issued for lower level contraventions;
- (b) 3,614 were issued on-street; and of this total
- 1,756 were issued for higher level contraventions;
