Allotment sites have been lost in Hungerford because of development and Marsh Lane was created as a result of pressure from the local community for the provision of allotments. Hungerford Town Council (HTC) lease the land and the allotment site has been developed and run by Hungerford Allotment Holders Association (HAHA). HAHA is made up of members who are allotment holders. The site started as simply a field and all the work and effort that has resulted in a remarkable community asset has come from the members of HAHA. It means that HTC are able to show that they have fulfilled their obligation to seek to provide allotments where there is an identifiable need.  Support for the site, since its inception, has come from West Berkshire and Hungerford Town Councils, North Wessex Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty NWAONB), Greenham Common Trust and local organisations. Hungerford is poorly provided with allotments. Marsh Lane is the only significant area of land set aside for allotments.  Through the use of the site, HAHA have been active in promoting healthy lifestyles, sustainability in food cultivation and .well being.  At the end of the last rental year (31 January 2020) the allotment site was full. This is an important asset of community value that has been created by the community of Hungerford. We believe that it meets the criteria to be registered as such.  Other details are provided in the attachment to this application. |
