## Your rights about your personal information

There are new rules about how Shared lives keep your personal information. The new rules are called the General Data Protection Regulations or GDPR.



The new rules give you rights about how Shared Lives keeps your personal information.

## What is personal information?

Personal information is information that can be used to identify you.

This includes:



## Who might have your personal information?

Many different organisations may have your personal information.

These include:

- Your doctor or any other part of the health services



- Your local council



- Any other service that you get – such as The Shared Lives Scheme



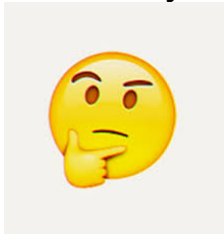
## Your right

You have the right to be told if anyone is collecting or using your personal information



You have the right to know:

- Why they have collected your personal information



- How long they will keep it for



- Who they will share it with
