Any person aggrieved by the Minerals and Waste Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power of the local authority, or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than six weeks from the day after the MWLP was adopted, before Friday 13 January 2023.
