Thank you for the consultation. There are no known archaeological features within this site and I think the potential for below ground heritage assets to be present is quite low. No condition is requested but I note that the Hollies originated as a late 19th century house, and that the grain of the landscape here (ie the field boundaries) is documented from the 19th century at least, with the woodland to the north, once called Hermits Hill Wood, having already been diminished.
