 The sloping nature of the terrain and lack of access for vehicles make it an ideal candidate for a Settlement Boundary
 The proposal might be sound if land to the west of Pincents Lane [for instance the derelict Pincents Manor site] or the largely unoccupied suite of offices at the end of the lane were used instead.*
