

WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, THATCHAM) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008

West Berkshire District Council in exercise of powers contained in Sections 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day of March 2008 and may be cited as the **WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, THATCHAM) (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008**
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 20 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
4. The West Berkshire District Council (Green Lane, Cedar Grove and Meadow Close, Thatcham) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and Road traffic regulation act 1967 Royal County of Berkshire (restricted roads, Thatcham) (No.3) Order 1973 are revoked in their entirety

SCHEDULE

IN THE TOWN OF THATCHAM 20 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT

Broadway	Between from a point 14 metres south of its junction with Bath Road (A4) to its junction with Station Road
Cedar Grove	for its entire length
Church Gate	for its entire length
Church Lane	for its entire length
Ferndale Court	for its entire length
Green Lane	Between from a point approximately 16 metres south of its junction with Bath Road (A4) to its junction with Church Gate
High Street	Between from a point 13 metres east of its junction with Bath Road (A4) to its junction with Broadway
Holywell Court	for its entire length
Malham Road	for its entire length
Meadow Close	for its entire length
Nideggen Close	for its entire length
Old Park Lane	for its entire length
Station Road	Between from a point 22 metres west of its junction with The Moors to its junction with Broadway
