(VARIOUS ROADS, IN THE TOWN OF THATCHAM) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2012

West Berkshire District Council in exercise of powers contained in Sections 84(1) and (2) to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the 23RD day of March 2012 and may be cited as the WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, IN THE TOWN OF THATCHAM) (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2012
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 20 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in Schedule to this Order
- Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
- Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle or vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 if that vehicle or vehicles is/are being used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
