WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, THATCHAM AND BUCKLEBURY) (40 MPH and 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013

West Berkshire District Council in exercise of powers contained in Sections 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the 7TH day of June 2013 and may be cited as the WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, THATCHAM AND BUCKLEBURY) (40 M.P.H. and 30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2013
- No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 40 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order
- No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 30 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order
- No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 30 M.P.H.
 on the length of road specified in the Schedule 3 to this Order
- No person shall drive any motor vehicle in any direction at a speed exceeding 30 M.P.H. on the length of road specified in the Schedule 4 to this Order
- Nothing in Articles 2, 3, 4 or 5 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion
- 7. The Order will revoke in their entirety the Orders specified in Schedule 5 to this Order
